Signed from Map Ref SP374588 on sheet 151, Postcode CV33 9NN. This is a crossroads 1 km south of Harbury. Access to the wood is south from here, 3.2 km down a private road. NB: There is no access from the B4451 at J12 of the M40 even though the wood is adjacent to it.

Parking is at Map Ref SP372582 on sheet 151. Charge £1 per vehicle.

Registration is from 10.00 to 12.00. Starts from 10.30 to 12.30.

Entries are on the day only. Seniors £7.00. Juniors £3.00.

The EMIT electronic punching system will be used. EMIT cards will be available for hire on the day if you don't have your own. (Seniors and Juniors - £1.00).

Payment by Card facility will be available.

Note that the map now has 2.5 metre contours rather than 5 metre (with a lot of form lines).

A black x means a tripod made of 3 branches taped together

A green x means a rootstock / large tree stump

Cultivated land (marked with the yellow and black dots) is Out of Bounds. The path that runs along the outside of the forest boundaries is also Out of Bounds.

Full details of which course you need to run are below. Two points to note:

1) You can run either in your own age class or in the Open class. Other than that, there is no "running up" allowed. e.g. an M60 can run the Vintage Men or Open Men but not in the Senior or Veteran classes. Similarly, a W16 can only run Junior Women or Open Women,

2) In some cases, these courses are not the same as the West Midlands League courses. However, you will still score points in the League based on the course you actually run.
