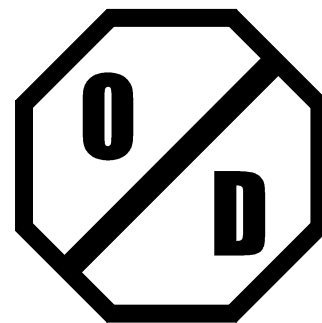

The Annual Tony Haw Score Event

at

Ryton Pools Country Park

on

Sunday 7th October 2018



Note for Schools: This event is ideal practice for anyone taking part in the British Schools Score Championships (BSSC) which takes place on Saturday, October 13th, at Moors Valley Country Park near Ringwood, on the Dorset/Hampshire border.

Travel: Ryton Pools Country Park is four miles south east of Coventry, one mile south west of the village of Ryton on Dunsmore. Signposted from the A445 just south west of its junction with the A423.

Car Park: Map Ref SP370725 on sheet 140. Post code is CV8 3BG. Entrance to the park is through a coin operated barrier and there is a charge for all vehicles. £3.50 per car. Correct change needed: £2, £1, 50p, 20p, 10p coins.

Entries: On the day only. Registration from 10.00 to 11.30 am.
Seniors: £6.00; Juniors and students: £2.00.
(Usual Sunday entry fees reduced to partially offset the cost of entering the park.)

Electronic punching: The EMIT electronic punching system will be used.
EMIT card hire £1.00 per card.

Start times: From 10.30 until 12.00.

Courses: 45 minute score event. Pre-marked maps. There will be a subset of controls forming a simple Yellow standard course, suitable for novices, although no-one is restricted to these controls and anyone may visit as many controls as the time allows. These rules are identical to those for the BSSC.

Terrain: Typical country park. A mixture of tracks, paths, grassland, young trees, old quarry pools, ancient woodland, etc.

Enjoy the other facilities: Visitor centre; Country café; Miniature Railway; Children's Playground; etc.
