West Midlands League Event & OD Club Champs Brandon Wood, Warwickshire on Sunday 8th December 2024

Travel:Nearest postcode CV3 3GW. OS Map reference SP386762.What3words:///path.ideal.tamed

Located on the southeast side of Coventry. From the A45 Coventry ring road (Stonebridge Highway), head south on the A45 towards Rugby. After about 100m, turn left after the Esso garage onto Brandon Lane. Head east on Brandon Lane for about 2km and parking is on your right, signed Brandon Marsh Nature Centre.

Car Park: Predominantly hard standing car parking. Please park as directed by the marshals. There is a road crossing between the car park and the start/finish & enquiries – this will also be marshalled. Please note TOILETS location below is NOT next to registration:



Toilets:	Located in Brandon Marsh visitor centre – Please remove muddy shoes before entering.
Dogs:	Dogs allowed. Please keep dogs under control at all times.
Times/ Start:	Registration from 10.00 to 12.00. Start times from 10.30 to 12.30. Start / finish approx. 250m from road crossing/registration. Courses close 14:00.
Entries:	Late Pre-Entry until Friday 6th Dec. Seniors £12 (non-BOF £14). Juniors and full-time students £4. Entry on the day: registration 10:00 to 11:30 by cash or card. (Late Pre-Entry and EOD subject to available maps)
Electronic punching:	SI (SIAC enabled) punching system will be used. SI cards (non-SIAC) will be available for hire if you don't have your own for £1. If you lose a hired SI-card there will be a charge of up to £52 for a lost card.
Courses:	Final course length, climb, controls:• White1.8 km / 15 m11 controls• Yellow2.2 km / 20 m11 controls• Orange2.6 km / 25 m11 controls• Light Green3.0 km / 40 m14 controls• Short Green4.0 km / 50 m14 controls• Green5.4 km / 65 m18 controls• Blue7.3 km / 110 m24 controls• Brown8.8 km / 125 m27 controls

Terrain: A mix of conifer plantation and ancient deciduous woodlands plus an old quarry for Blue and Brown courses. There are now significant areas of bramble in Brandon Wood but the majority can be avoided using the extensive network of paths and tracks.

Map: Scale of 1:10,000. ISOM 2017-2 map by Bruce Bryant with selective revisions in 2022 and 2024


ForestrySince the maps were printed at the start of December there has beenwork:forestry work in the eastern part of the area.


One linear area—adjacent to a large path—does not significantly affect courses, and it is obvious there have been recent "clearing" works. This area is likely to be encountered on Light Green and longer courses and is just to the West of control 167 on these courses.

The other area – just to the North of control 206 on Short Green, Green and Blue – is more significant and there is planned work on Sunday morning. The working party will be present in the Wood from 10:00 until 13:00 using both machinery and hand tools. Some of the work can create hazards so competitors should give a wide berth. Competitors are requested to be mindful, for the sake of safety, that any instruction given by a member of the working party must be complied with. Two paths leading into the area will be taped off – do not cross these tapes if you encounter them.

For control 206, you should aim to approach the control from the S or E - it should be visible from the path - and you must avoid the OOB area to the NW of the control. A map of 206 will be displayed at the pre-start.
